

OFFICIAL SCHOOL INFORMATION

The first day of student attendance – K-12 will be on Monday, August 27, 2018. **PLEASE NOTE: THIS WILL BE A FULL DAY OF ATTENDANCE.** School days will run from **8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.** at the Elementary School and from **8:00 A.M. to 3:11 P.M.** at the Jr.-Sr. High School.

The first day for PASS will be Tuesday, August 28, 2018.

The cafeterias will go into operation on Monday, August 27th. **Lunch prices are \$2.35 for grades K-5, \$2.60 for grades 6-12, and \$3.10 for adult meals. Milk for cold lunch is 30 cents a carton.** Letters regarding free and reduced price meals/milk will be sent home with your children when school begins.

Physical exams are required for all students entering **Preschool, Kindergarten, 6th Grade and 9th Grade**, as well as those students entering an Illinois school for the first time. **Physicals are also required for all students who participate in district athletic programs.** Athletic physicals must be presented before the student will be allowed to practice. Hepatitis B, HIB, Varicella and Pneumococcal vaccinations are required for children entering the **Preschool** program. All students entering **Kindergarten** will be required to have a lead screening done with the physical. **If your child has not had the chickenpox, they will be required to receive two doses of the Varicella vaccine before entering Kindergarten, 6th or 9th Grades.** All students entering **6th Grade** will need to have the Hepatitis B vaccinations if they have not received them earlier. **New requirement:** All students entering the 6th and 12th grades will be required to show proof of recent meningococcal conjugate vaccination (MCV). All 6th graders will be required to show proof of one dose received on or after 11 years of age. All 12th graders will need to show proof of receiving two doses unless the first dose was administered after 16 years of age. In this case, only one dose after 16 years of age is required. **Documentation from your doctor needs to be turned in by the first day of school.**

Dental exams are required for students entering **Kindergarten, 2nd and 6th Grades.**

A complete eye exam done by an eye doctor is required for all **Kindergarten** students.

Physical, Dental & Eye Exam forms can be turned in at registration or on the first day of school

School insurance forms will be distributed on the 1st day of school. This year our student insurance for 2018-2019 is provided for each enrolled student at no cost. A brochure and letter explaining the insurance will be sent home with your student on the first day of school.

Registration – District wide registration will be held at the Jr./Sr. High School Building in the LMC for **ALL** Pre-K through 12th Grade returning students on **Wednesday, August 1st from 1:00 - 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 – 8:00 P.M. and Thursday, August 2nd from 8:00 – 11:00 A.M.** New student registration for both schools will be on **Friday, August 3rd from 8:00 A.M. – Noon** in each respective building.

Parents: You will be required to attend one of the above listed dates.

Fees will be collected at the time of registration. Fees would include book rental, PE articles, athletic/activity participation fees, instrument rentals, lab fees, fluoride fee, milk snack fee and lunch account money (optional). Fees are as follows:

Junior High Boys' Basketball, and Junior High Girls' Basketball - **\$25.00/each**
Volleyball, Boys' Basketball, Girls' Basketball, Baseball and Softball- **\$35.00/each**

Instrumental Rental:

1. Student owns & uses his/her own instrument – No Fee
2. Student uses school owned instrument to accommodate practicing/instructor's request – No Fee
3. Student does not own instrument – uses a school owned instrument - \$50.00 non-refundable, not to exceed \$100.00 per year per family
4. Student uses school's percussion equipment - \$35.00 non-refundable, not to exceed \$70.00 per year per family
