Dear Parents:

On Wednesday, April 5, 2017, Orangeville Juniors, as well as juniors throughout the state, took the SAT, a scholastic assessment. Students may elect to retake the exam during their senior year to see if they can improve upon their previous score. The SAT is given on selected dates and test centers throughout the year. The fall dates are August 26, October 7, November 4, and December 2, 2017. There are also dates in March, May, & June 2018. The closest test center is Highland Community College. SAT registration and exam dates can be found at www.collegeboard.org. If the test is taken more than once, the school will place the highest score on the permanent transcript.

Due to the fact that students were required to take the SAT exam on April 5th, SAT cannot require that the scores be placed on the student's transcripts. **These SAT scores can be placed on the student's transcript only with permission of the student (or permission of the student's parents/guardians if the student is less than 18 years of age).** Many colleges and universities require SAT or ACT scores for admission. Please return this form to the high school office if you wish to have the SAT scores placed on the transcript. When your son or daughter requests that their high school transcript (grades) be sent to a college or university the SAT scores will be on that transcript.
